2. Pursuant to the Amended and Restated Plan of Conversion and Reorganization of United Community MHC, each share of common stock of old United Community Bancorp was exchanged for 0.6573 share of the issuer's common stock.
3. The exercise price per share of each converted old United Community Bancorp option was determined by dividing the \$11.53 exercise price of the old United Community Bancorp option by the 0.6573 exchange ratio.
4. Pursuant to the Amended and Restated Plan of Conversion and Reorganization of United Community MHC, each option to purchase a share of common stock of old United Community Bancorp was converted into an option to purchase 0.6573 share of the issuer's common stock, rounded down to the nearest whole share.
5. Stock options are fully vested and exercisable.
