Explanation of Responses:

- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: 35,558 restricted shares were awarded pursuant to H.B. Fuller Company's Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan. This amount includes 4,165 restricted shares that vested effective December 4, 2009; 3,557 restricted shares that vested effective December 6, 2010; 7,746 restricted shares that vested effective December 4, 2011; 7,261 restricted shares that vested in three equal annual installments beginning on December 3, 2010; 6,535 restricted shares that will vest in three equal annual installments beginning on January 20, 2012; and 6,294 restricted shares that will vest in three equal annual installments beginning on January 26, 2013. Total amount also includes restricted shares acquired pursuant to a dividend accrual feature of the Amended and Restated 2000 Year Stock Incentive Plan.
- 401(k) Plan: This amount includes shares and dividends acquired pursuant to the H.B.Fuller Company 401(k) & Retirement Plan.
- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option vests in three equal annual installments beginning on January 24, 2014.
- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: These restricted stock units convert into shares of common stock on a 1-for-1 basis.
- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: These restricted stock units vest in three equal annual installments beginning on January 24, 2014.
- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option vests in three equal annual installments beginning on January 20, 2012.
- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option vests in three equal annual installments beginning on January 26, 2013.
- 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option is 100% vested.
- Amended and Restated Year 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: This option is 100% vested.
- Deferred Compensation Plan: These units (acquired after 12-31-04) convert into shares of common stock on a 1-for-1 basis.
- Deferred Compensation Plan: These units (acquired after 12-31-04) convert into shares of common stock upon the earlier of certain termination events as specified in the Key Employee Deferred Compensation Plan or such earlier date as selected by the participant, subject to holding periods required by law.
- Key Employee Deferred Compensation Plan Dividend Reinvestment: This amount (acquired after 12-31-04) includes stock units acquired pursuant to a dividend equivalent feature of the Key Employees' Deferred Compensation Plan.
