ITEM 6. OWNERSHIP OF MORE THAN 5% ON BEHALF OF ANOTHER PERSON:

The Prudential Insurance Company of America ("Prudential") may have direct or indirect voting and/or investment discretion over 568,649 shares of the Issuer's common stock. This number includes 14,149 warrants to purchase common stock, which convert at a ratio of 1:1. These securities are held for the benefit of Prudential's clients by its registered investment companies and its subsidiary Prudential Securities Incorporated. Prudential is reporting the combined holdings of these entities for the purpose of administrative convenience.

These shares were acquired in the ordinary course of business, and not with the purpose or effect of changing or influencing control of the Issuer.
