(NASDAQ:PSAI) today announced that, effective with the open of business on March 22, 1999, the listing of the PSAI's Common Stock will move to The Nasdaq SmallCap Market. The stock symbol will remain the same. As previously reported, PSAI's common stock failed to meet the minimum bid price and minimum value of the public float requirements for continued listing on The Nasdaq National Market due to the decline in the market price of the stock.
